## Fruit Coasters

### MATERIALS

Anchor Creativa – 1 ball of each:

Yarn A 00105; Yarn B 00205; Yarn C 00254; Yarn D 00390; Yarn E 00389; Yarn F 00281

### STITCHES

Double Crochet DC

Half Treble Crochet HTR

Treble Crochet TR

Slip Stitch SS

### SPECIAL STITCH

FPTR--Front Post Triple or Treble Crochet--Yarn over (YO) hook two times. Insert hook behind post of stitch (st). YO hook, pull up a loop, four loops on hook. YO hook, pull through 2 loops, 3 loops on hook. YO hook, pull through 2 loops, 2 loops on hook. YO hook, pull through last two loops.

### KIWI (2)

Rounds 1-6 will start with a ch-3 (counts as first tr). Close with a sl st each round.

Using Yarn A make a magic loop.

Round 1: 12tr into the loop. (12sts)

Round 2: 2tr in each tr around. (24 sts)

Using Yarn B

Round 3:( tr in next tr, 2tr in next tr) 12 times. (36)

Round 4:( tr in next 2 tr, 2tr in next tr) 12 times. (48)

Round 5:( tr in next 3 tr, 2tr in next tr) 12 times. (60)

Round 6:( tr in next 4 tr, 2tr in next tr) 12 times. (72)

Using Yarn C

Round 7 will start with a ch-1 (counts as first dc). Close with a sl st.

Round 7: Dc in each st around.

Fasten off

Embroider the seeds using the photo as a guide.

### WATERMELON (2)

Each round will start with a ch-3 (counts as first tr). Close with a sl st each round.

Using Yarn D make a magic loop.

Round 1: 12tr into the loop. (12sts)

Round 2: 2tr in each dc around. (24 sts)

Round 3:( tr in next tr, 2tr in next tr) 12 times. (36)

Round 4:( tr in next 2 tr, 2tr in next tr) 12 times. (48)

Round 5:( tr in next 3 tr, 2tr in next tr) 12 times. (60)

Using Yarn A

Round 6:( tr in next 4 tr, 2tr in next tr) 12 times. (72)

Using Yarn E

Round 7: Tr in each st around.

Fasten off

Embroider the seeds using the photo as a guide.

### ORANGE (2)

Each round will start with a ch-2 (counts as first htr). Close with a sl st each round.

Using Yarn A make a magic loop.

Round 1: 12htr into the loop. (12sts)

Round 2: ( FPtr around htr on row below, using Yarn F 2htr in next htr) 8 times. (24)

Round 3: ( FPtr around FRhtr on row below, using Yarn F, 1htr in next htr, 2htr in next htr) 8 times. (32)

Round 4: ( FPtr around FRhtr on row below, using Yarn F, 1htr in next 2 htr, 2htr in next htr) 8 times. (40)

Round 5: ( FPtr around FRhtr on row below, using Yarn F, 1htr in next htr, 3htr in next htr) 8 times. (48)

Round 6: ( FPtr around FRhtr on row below, using Yarn F, 1htr in next htr, 4htr in next htr) 8 times. (54)

Round 7: ( FPtr around FRhtr on row below, using Yarn F, 1htr in next htr, 5htr in next htr) 8 times. (62)

Using Yarn A

Round 8: ( htr in next 7 tr, 2htr in next tr) 8 times. (70)

Using Yarn F

Round 9: ( htr in next 8 tr, 2htr in next tr) 8 times. (78)

Fasten off

### WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

All our threads are produced in accordance with Oeko-Tex standards. PH values are tested and all our colour dye lots adhere to Global fastness standards.

However, it is important to follow our thread washing instructions. Particularly with dark colors, excess dye can remain on the thread. To minimise any potential bleeding of excess dyestuff it is important to wash the products in THE HOTTEST TEMPERATURE possible, in accordance with the specifications of the fabrics, and use a large amount of water. Please make sure that you also follow the fabric washing instructions where appropriate. As a precaution, you can also use decolorating sheets that you can find in any
