Toy Stuffing Yarn Needle Black embroidery thread

# GAUGE

5dc = 2.5cm / 1 inch

# ABBREVIATIONS

## **PATTERN NOTES:**

This pattern is worked in the amigurumi style (unless specified), in a spiral without slip stitching or turning chains

**Invisible decreases:** Decreases in this pattern are worked in the following manner - Insert hook in the FRONT LOOP ONLY of the st indicated and pull up a loop (two loops on hook), Insert hook in the FRONT LOOP ONLY of the next st, yarn over, pull through three loops on hook. Working a decrease in this way helps reduce appearance of holes that can be made when working a decrease the normal way.

Joining pieces together: Leave a long yarn tail when fastening off (unless specified) to use to join parts together.

**How to make hair:** Fold two strands of yarn in half so that there's a U-shaped bend on one side and four 'tails' on the other side. Insert your hook around a stitch where you want to add the hair on the head catch the bend of your yarn with your hook, pull the folded end of the yarn under the stitch taking care not to pull the yarn all the way through. The ends of the yarn should remain on the opposite side of the stitch as the folded end. Open up the fold of the yarn so that you have a loop. Insert the tail ends of yarn into the loop. Pull the ends of the yarn tightly to cinch the loop down into a knot.

Blusher: used in this pattern is just normal makeup

#### **SPECIAL STITCHES:**

**Make Bobble (MB):** Make Bobble (MB) \* yo, insert hook in indicated st, pull up a loop, \* repeat from \* to \* 3 times (9 loops on hook), yo and pull through all loops on hook, continue with the next st as normal.

# CROCHET PATTERN HEAD:

Rnd 1: With A and a 3mm hook; working into a magic ring, 6dc. 6sts Rnd 2: [2dc] around. 12sts Rnd 3: [1dc, 2dc] around. 18sts Rnd 4: [1dc in next 2sts, 2dc] around. 24sts Rnd 5: [1dc in next 3sts, 2dc] around. 30sts Rnd 6: [1dc in next 4sts, 2dc] around. 36sts Rnds 7-12: Dc around. Rnd 13: 1dc in 17sts, MB, 1dc in 18sts around. The bobble st is the nose of your angel. Rnds 14-16: Dc around. Embroider eyes in between rnd 10 - 11 approx 5sts apart with the nose in-between. Embroider a smile over rnd 17 Rnd 17: [1dc in next 4sts, dc2tog] around. 30sts Rnd 18: [1dc in next 3sts, dc2tog] around. 24sts Rnd 19: [1dc in next 2sts, dc2tog] around. 18sts Rnd 20: Dc around. Fasten off but leave yarn tail Stuff the head.

# BODY:

Working from the neck downwards; Rnds 1 - 4: With B and a 3mm hook; make as Head. 24sts Rnd 5: Dc around Rnd 6: [1dc in next 3sts, 2dc] around. 30sts Rnds 7 - 9: Dc around. Rnd 10: [1dc in next 4sts, 2dc] around. 36sts Rnds 11 - 18: Dc around. Rnd 19: [1dc in next 5sts, 2dc] around. 42sts Rnds 20 - 24: Dc around. Rnd 25: BLO; [1dc in next 6sts, 2dc] around. 48sts Rnds 26 - 27: Dc around. Rnd 28: [1dc in next 6sts, dc2tog] around. 42sts Rnd 29: [1dc in next 5sts, dc2tog] around. 36sts Rnd 30: [1dc in next 4sts, dc2tog] around. 30sts Start to stuff; continue to stuff as you go. Rnd 31: [1dc in next 3sts, dc2tog] around. 24sts Rnd 32: [1dc in next 2sts, dc2tog] around. 18sts Rnd 33: [1dc, dc2tog] around. 12sts Rnd 34: [dc2tog] around. 6sts Fasten off, using the yarn tail sew together the remaining 6sts, then pass

Fasten off, using the yarn tail sew together the remaining 6sts, then pass the yarn tail up and through the neck of your angel and secure, to help keep the base of the angels dress lie flat.

**Rnd 35:** Attach D to any FLO st of rnd 25; Dc around. Fasten off and weave in ends.



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# HANDS (MAKE 2):

Hands are not stuffed; **Rnd 1:** With A and a 3mm hook; working into a magic ring, 8dc. 8sts **Rnds 2 - 6:** Dc around Fasten off but leave yarn tail

# SLEEVES (MAKE 2):

Sleeves are not stuffed; Rnd 1: With B and a 3mm hook; ch11, sl st to form a ring, Dc around. 11sts Rnds 2 – 8: Dc around Rnd 9: Dc2tog, dc around. 10sts Rnd 10: Dc2tog, dc around. 9sts Rnd 11: Dc2tog, dc around. 8sts Rnd 12: Dc2tog, dc around. 7sts Fasten off, using the yarn tail sew together the remaining 7sts, leave a yarn tail Rnd 13: Attach D to rnd 1; Dc around. Fasten off and weave in ends.

# WINGS (MAKE 2):

Holding C and D together and using a 4mm hook;
Row 1: Ch13, 1dc in the second ch from the hook, 1dc in each st across until end, turn. 12sts
Row 2: Ch1, 1dc across, turn
Row 3: Miss st, sl st in the next 3sts, ch1, 2dc in the same st as the beginning ch1, 1dc across, turn. 10sts
Row 4: Ch1, 1dc across, turn
Row 5: Miss st, sl st in 3sts, ch1, 2dc in the first st, 1dc in 6sts, turn. 8sts
Row 6: Ch1, 1dc across, turn
Row 7: Miss st, sl st in 3sts, ch1, 2dc in the first st, 1dc in 4sts, turn. 6sts
Row 8: Ch1, 1dc across, turn
Row 9: Miss st, sl st in 3sts, ch1, 2dc in the first st, 1dc in 2sts, turn. 4sts
Row 10: Ch1, 1dc across, turn
Row 11: dc2tog 1dc in the next 2sts. 3sts
Fasten off but leave yarn tail

# HAIR:

Cut several lengths of yarn approx 31cm long then attached as per guidance. I added hair on the first 5 rnds of the head.

#### HALO:

With E and a 3mm hook make a ch that it long enough to fit around the angels head, sl st to form a ring, fasten off and weave in ends.

# MAKING UP:

- Attach head to the top of the body
- Attach hands slightly inside the sleeves
- Attach sleeves to either side of the body; attaching them so the hands are on the front of the body (as per the photos)
- Add hair to the top of the head (as per guidance)
- Join flat row ends of wings together, then attach the wings centrally to the back of the body
- Add halo so it sits around the head
- Add blusher to the cheeks (optional)

# WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

All our threads are produced in accordance with Oeko-Tex standards. PH values are tested and all our colour dye lots adhere to Global fastness standards. However, it is important to follow our thread washing instructions. Particularly with dark colors, excess dye can remain on the thread. To minimise any potential bleeding of excess dyestuff it is important to wash the products in THE HOTTEST TEMPERATURE possible, in accordance with the specifications of the fabrics, and use a large amount of water. Please make sure that you also follow the fabric washing instructions where appropriate. As a precaution, you can also use decolorating sheets that you can find in any supermarket.



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
