MATERIALS

Aunt Lydia's® Baby Shower™ (170 yds/155 m)

Bunny Version

Contrast A Yellow (7330) 1 ball Contrast B White (0100) 1 ball

Bear Version

Contrast A Dark Dogwood (8820) 1 ball Contrast B Natural (8010) 1 ball

Size U.S. D/3 (3.25 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Black felt. Black embroidery floss. White embroidery floss. Pink embroidery floss (for Bunny Teether only). Polyfill stuffing. 31/2" [9 cm] wooden ring. Yarn needle.





ABBREVIATIONS

Alt = Alternate(ing) **Rem** = Remaining Rnd(s) = Round(s)Approx = **RS** = Right side Approximately **Beg** = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)**Dc** = Double crochet

Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 sc. Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook

MEASUREMENTS

Bunny: Approx 7" 18 cm] tall, including ring.

Bear: Approx 5" [12.5 cm],

including ring

Both characters: Head approx 2" [5 cm] diameter

GAUGE

22 sc and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm]

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes

- Each Teether is made from 8 pieces: Head, Nose, 2 Ears, 2 Eyes, Ring Cover, and Ruff.
- Head, Nose, Ring Cover, and Ruff are worked the same for both Teethers.

- Separate instructions are provided for Bunny Nose, Ears and Eyes and for Bear Nose, Ears, and Eyes.
- · Join all rnds with sl st to first sc/st.

HEAD

With A, make an adjustable ring:

Wrap yarn into a ring, ensuring that the tail falls behind the working yarn. Grip ring and tail between middle finger and thumb. Insert hook through center of ring, yarn over (with working yarn) and draw up a loop. Work stitches of first round in the ring. After the first round of stitches is worked, pull gently on tail to tighten ring.

1st rnd: Ch 1. 8 sc in ring. Join with sl st in first sc. 8 sc.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as sl st. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 16 sc.

3rd rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in next sc. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 24 sc.

4th rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Rep from * around. Join. 32 sc.

5th rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Rep from * around Join. 40 sc.

6th rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. Rep from * around. Join. 48 sc.

7th to 12th rnds: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join.

13th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first Turn. 5 sc. 2 sc. Sc2tog. *1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * around. Join, 36 sts.

14th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. Sc2tog, *1 sc in next st. Sc2tog. Rep from * around. Join. 24 sts.

15th rnd: Ch 1. *Sc2tog. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first st. 12 sts.

Fasten off, leaving a 12-18" [30.5-45.5 cm] long tail. Stuff head firmly. Thread long tail through rem sts and pull to close opening. Secure end but do not cut tail, it will be used later to sew Head to covered rina.

BUNNY NOSE

With A, make an adjustable ring as given for Head.

1st to 4th: As 1st to 4th rnds of **14th row:** Ch 1. (1 sc in first st. Head, 32 sc at end of last rnd. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. With

yarn tail, sew Nose to Head adding a very small amount of polyfill to Nose as you sew.

BUNNY EARS (make 2)

With A, ch 6, leaving a long tail for sewing Ear to Head.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch to end of chain.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. (2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc) twice. Turn. 7 sc.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

2 sc. 2 sc in next sc) twice. 1 sc in last st. Turn. 9 sc.

5th row: As 3rd row.

6th row: Ch 1. (1 sc in each of first 3 sc. 2 sc in next st) twice. 1 sc in last st. Turn. 11 sc.

7th to 9th rows: As 3rd row.

10th row: Ch 1. (1 sc in each of first of Head. 24 sc at end of last rnd. 3 sc. Sc2tog) twice. 1 sc in last st. Turn. 9 sts.

11th and alt rows: As 3rd row. **12th row:** Ch 1. (1 sc in first 2 sc. Sc2tog) twice. 1 sc in last st. Turn. 7 sts.

Sc2tog) twice. 1 sc in last st. Turn. 5 sts.

16th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in next given for Head. st. Sc2tog. Turn. 3 sts.

17th row: As 3rd row.

sewing. Using photograph as a Turn. 8 hdc. guide, sew Ears to Head.

BUNNY EYES (make 2)

Cut two ¾" [19 mm] circles from black felt. Using photograph as a guide, applique Eyes to Head. With white embroidery floss,

embroider outline stitch along lower edge of each Eye.

With white embroidery floss, **4th row:** Ch 1. (1 sc in each of first embroider a French knot on each Eye as highlight.

BEAR NOSE

With A, make an adjustable ring, as given for Head.

1st to 3rd rnds: As 1st to 3rd rnds

4th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. With yarn tail, sew Nose to Head adding a very small amount of polyfill to Nose as you sew.

BEAR EARS (make 2)

With A, make an adjustable ring, as

Row 1: 4 sc in ring. Turn. 4 sc.

Row 2: Ch 2 (does not count as st). Fasten off, leaving a long tail for 2 hdc in each hdc to end of row.

> Row 3: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Using photograph as a guide, sew Ears to Head.

BEAR EYES (make 2)

Cut two ½" [13 mm] circles from black felt. Using photograph as a guide, applique Eyes to Head. With white embroidery floss, embroider outline stitch along lower edge of each Eye.

With white embroidery floss, embroider a French knot on each Eye as highlight.

RING COVER

With B, ch 23.

1st row: 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch to end of chain. Turn, 21 hdc.

2nd to 5th rows: Ch 2. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn.

Joining row: Wrap cover over ring and bring first and last row tog with sts matching. Working through both thicknesses, slip st in each st across to attach cover to ring. Fasten off and weave in end.

RUFF

With B, ch 16.

1st row: 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch to end of chain. Turn, 30 sc.

2nd and 3rd rows: Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn, 60 sc. Fasten off at end of last row, leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

With yarn tail still attached to Head, sew Head to center of Ring Cover.

Place Ruff around base of Head, where it is joined to Ring Cover. With yarn tail still attached to Ruff, sew short ends of Ruff together.

Weave in ends.
