

Bear Pen Case

OTHER SUPPLIES

Boutons pression 30mm Tapestry needle

NOTE:

Use the double thread to give more strength to the case.

PATTERN:

Whit MC Ch40. Turn.

Row 1: Ch1, dc in each ch. Turn (40 sts) Rows 2- 54: Ch1, dc in each dc. Turn

Rows 55- 65: Dc2tog, dc in each dc to end, turn.

Fasten off.

Fold the first 54 turns of the in 2 parts to form the inside of the pen case. Sew the lining in the remaining part and sew the button for closure.

Join CC1 with a ss to any st and dc evenly around edge, ss to first dc to join. Fasten off and weave in ends.

BOW

Whit CC3 Ch6. Turn.

Row 1: Ch1, dc in each ch. Turn (40 sts) Rows 2- 16: Ch1, dc in each dc. Turn

Fold the bow in two and roll the thread of the same color in the central part to make the bow shape.

EYES (MAKE 2)

Whit CC2 make a magic ring.

Rnd 1: 10dc into magic ring.

Rnd 2: 10dc

Rnd 3: Whit CC3 10dc.

Fasten off.

CHEEKS (MAKE 2)

Whit CC1 make a magic ring. **Rnd 1:** 12dc into magic ring.

Rnd 2: 2dc into each dc. 24dc.

Fasten off.

NOSE

With CC4 Ch6. Turn

Row 1: Dc2tog, dc in each dc to end, turn. 5dc.

Repeat last row until only 2 st remain.

Next Row. Dc2tog.

Fasten off.

EARS (MAKE 2)

Whit CC1 make a magic ring. **Rnd 1:** 12dc into magic ring. **Rnd 2:** 2dc into each dc. 24dc.

Rnds 3-4: 24dc **Rnd 5:** Whit MC 24dc.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

With the white thread embroider a small white line in the black side of the eye.

Stitch your eyes on the front of the case. (12 st apart)

Sew your nose in the middle of your eyes and embroider your mouth. (See the photo as an example)

Sew the cheeks in the lower front side.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

All our threads are produced in accordance with Oeko-Tex standards. PH values are tested and all our colour dye lots adhere to Global fastness standards. However, it is important to follow our thread washing instructions. Particularly with dark colors, excess dye can remain on the thread. To minimise any potential bleeding of excess dyestuff it is important to wash the products in THE HOTTEST TEMPERATURE possible, in accordance with the specifications of the fabrics, and use a large amount of water. Please make sure that you also follow the fabric washing instructions where appropriate. As a precaution, you can also use decolorating sheets that you can find in any supermarket.
