

Enchanting Doll

TENSION

22 sts and 25 rows = 10×10 cm in double crochet

TENSION (LEG WARMERS)

22 sts and 25 rows = 32 sts and 44 rows = 10×10 cm in stockinette stitch

ABBREVIATIONS

ΜR Magic Ring Ch Chain Double Crochet Dc Stitch St SI St Slip stitch Half Treble Crochet Htr Inc Increase Dec Decrease BLO back loop only FLO front only YO Yarn over

BASIC PATTERN

Chain. Slip Stitch. Double Crochet. Half Treble Crochet.

SPIRAL ROUNDS: to identify the beginning round, place a stitch marker. Do not close with 1 sl st. Start the round with 1 dc in the first dc of the previous round.

INTARSIA CROCHET TECHNIQUE: work with one thread for each colour. Leave the thread of the 2nd colour on the wrong side and work the double crochet with the colour in progress by, inserting the crochet into the base knit and underneath the thread of the 2nd colour dragged with the left hand. When the colour changes, close the last stitch of the colour in which you are working with the colour of the next stitch.

INCREASE: make 2 stitch in same stitch.

DECREASE (INVISIBLE DECREASE FOR AMIGURUMI): work 2 dc together as follows: Insert needle in FL (front loop) of first stitch, hold, then insert needle in the FL of second stitch, **yo pull through both loops**, yo and fasten off all loops on hook.

NOTES

Head and body (dress) are just one piece, as well as boots and legs. To make head and neck stronger, before finish stuffing the head, put a small and thin cardboard cylinder inside the neck and stuff around.

HEAD

Use 3 mm crochet hook and Anchor Creativa Fino skin tone yarn 00363. **Round 1**: Make a Magic Ring with 6 dc = 6. Continue by working in spiral rounds. **Round 2**: 1 inc x 6 = 12

Round 3: $(1 \text{ dc}, 1 \text{ inc}) \times 6 \text{ times} = 18$. Round 4: $(2 \text{ dc}, 1 \text{ inc}) \times 6 \text{ times} = 24$. Round 5: $(3 \text{ dc}, 1 \text{ inc}) \times 6 \text{ times} = 30$. Round 6: $(4 \text{ dc}, 1 \text{ inc}) \times 6 \text{ times} = 36$. Round 7: $(5 \text{ dc}, 1 \text{ inc}) \times 6 \text{ times} = 42$. Rounds 8 to 15: 1 dc in each st = 42 (8 round).

* On Round 12 with Anchor Stranded Cotton 00403 embroider the eyes and eyelids in straight stitches.

* Between Rounds 13/14 with Anchor Stranded Cotton 00336 embroider nose in straight stitches (in the middle of the eyes).

Two rows below the nose embroider mouth with Anchor Stranded Cotton 00868.

Round 16: (5 dc, 1 dec) x 6 times = 36. **Round 17**: (4 dc, 1 dec) x 6 times = 30.

Round 17: (4 dc, 1 dec) x 6 times = 30. **Round 18**: (3 dc, 1 dec) x 6 times = 24. Put some filling to make the head firm. **Round 19**: (2 dc, 1 dec) x 6 times = 18. **Round 20**: (4 dc, 1 dec) x 3 times = 15. **Round 21**: 1 dc in each st = 15

Continue crocheting the body.

BODY / DRESS

Change to Anchor Creativa Fino red yarn 01333.

Round 1: (4 dc, 1 inc) \times 3 times = 18. Finish stuffing the head, make sure stays firm.

Round 2: (2 dc, 1 inc) x 6 times = 24.

Round 3: (3 dc, 1 inc) x 6 times = 30.

Round 4: (4 dc, 1 inc) x 6 times = 36.

Rounds 5 to 7: 1 dc in each st = 36. On Round 5 stuff again, paying attention the neck stays firm.

Round 8: 8 dc, 1 inc, 17 dc, 1 inc, 9 dc = 38.

Round 9: 9 dc, 1 inc, 18 dc, 1 inc, 9 dc = 40.

Round 10: 1 dc in each st = 40.

Round 11: Start the crochet intarsia as chart (use Anchor Creativa Fino red yarn 01333 and white yarn 01331): (3 dc red, 1 dc white) repeat until end of row (the round finishes with 1 dc white) = 40.

Rounds 12 and 13: With red yarn 1 dc in each st = 40.

* Round 14: Repeat round 11 = 40.

Rounds 15 and 16: Repeat rounds 12 and 13 = 40* Stuff.

Repeat *to* until you reach round 22. **Round 23**: (**FLO** 1 dc red, 1 dc white) repeat until end of row (the round finishes with1 dc white) = 40.

You have finished the dress, now continue crocheting the bottom. Finish stuffing.

BOTTOM

The first round of the bottom is also Round 23 worked in back loops. Round 1: BLO 1 dc in each st = 40.

Round 2: 8 dc, 2 dec, 16 dc, 2 dec, 8 dc = 36.

Round 3: 7 dc, 2 dec, 14 dc, 2 dec, 7 dc = 32.

Round 4: 6 dc, 2 dec, 12 dc, 2 dec, 6 dc = 28.

Round 5: 6 dc, 2 dec, 9 dc, 2 dec, 5 dc = 24.

Round 6: 5 dc, 2 dec, 7 dc, 2 dec, 4 dc = 20.

Leave the hole open to sew the legs.

BOOTS (MAKE 2)

Use 3 mm crochet hook and Anchor Creativa Fino red yarn 01333. Each round of the boots and legs are closed with sl st. Make Ch 9. **Round 1**: In second ch from hook make 2 dc, 5 dc, 2 dc in each of the two

Round 1: In second ch from hook make 2 dc, 5 dc, 2 dc in each of the two last sts. Turn, to the other side of the chain and make 5 dc, 2 dc in the last st.

Close the row with sl st in the first dc = 18.

Round 2: Ch 1 (does not count as st), 2 dc in each of the two first sts, 5 dc, 2 dc in each of the next four sts, 5 dc, 2 dc in each of the two last sts = 26. **Round 3**: Ch 1 (does not count as st), 2 dc, 1 inc., 7 dc, 1 inc, 4 dc, 1 inc, 7 dc, 1 inc, 2 dc = 30.

Round 4: Ch 1 (does not count as st), BLO 1 dc in each st = 30. **Rounds 5 and 6**: Ch 1 (does not count as st), 1 dc in each st = 30. **Round 7**: Ch 1 (does not count as st), 10 dc, 5 dec, 9 dc, skip 1 st = 24. **Round 8**: Ch 1 (does not count as st), 7 dc, 5 dec, 7 dc = 19. **Round 9**: Ch 1 (does not count as st), 7 dc, 3 dec, 6 dc = 16. **Round 10**: Ch 1 (does not count as st), 7 dc, 2 dec, 5 dc = 14. **Round 11**: **FLO** 14 dc. Stuff the boots make sure stay firm.

LEGS (MAKE 2)

Legs are made of stripes. (Use Anchor Creativa Fino red yarn 01333 and white yarn 01331).

Continue from boots with white yarn. **Round 1**: **BLO** 14 dc (only first round) Make 4 rounds = White stripe. With red yarn make also 4 rounds = Red stripe. Put a little stuffing in the beginning of legs.

Alternate white stripe and red stripe until you have 11 stripes. (Begin with white yarn and finish also with white yarn).

Cut the yarn and leave a long tail to sew.

LEG WARMERS (MAKE 2)

Use Anchor Metallic Red 00318 and the 2,5 mm knitting bamboo needles Cast on 12 sts.

Row 1 (right side): Knit 12. Row 2 (wrong side): Purl 12. Repeat row 1 and row 2 until you have 7,5 cm long. Sew both ends. Turn wrong side out and put it on legs before sew to the body.

ARMS (MAKE 2)

Use 3 mm crochet hook and Anchor Creativa Fino skin tone 00363. **Round 1**: Make a Magic Ring with 5 dc = 5. **Round 2**: $(1 dc , 1 inc) \times 2 times, 1 dc = 7.$ **Round 3**: $(1 dc , 1 inc) \times 3 times, 1 dc = 10.$ **Rounds 4 to 8**: Change to Anchor Creativa Fino red yarn 01333, 1 dc in each st = 10. Put a small part of stuffing just in the hand. **Round 9**: $(3 dc , 1 dec) \times 2 times = 8.$ **Round 10**: 1 dc in each st = 8. **Round 11**: 1 dc, 1 dec, 5 dc = 7. **Rounds 12 and 13**: 1 dc in each st = 7. Cut the yarn, leave a tail to sew.

HAT

Use 3 mm crochet hook and Anchor Creativa Fino red yarn 01333. Every round of the hat begin with ch 1 (does not count as st) and is closed with sl st in the 1st dc.

Chain 45 and make a circle with sl st (be careful not to twist the chain). Rounds 1 to 8: Ch 1, 1 dc in each st = 45. **Round 9**: Ch 1, (13 dc, 1 dec) x 3 times = 42. **Round 10**: Ch 1, 1 dc in each st = 42. **Round 11**: Ch 1, (12 dc, 1 dec) x 3 times = 39. Round 12: Ch 1, (11 dc, 1 dec) x 3 times = 36. **Rounds 13 and 14**: Ch 1, 1 dc in each st = 36. **Round 15**: Ch 1, (7 dc, 1 dec) x 4 times = 32. **Round 16**: Ch 1, 1 dc in each st = 32. **Round 17**: Ch 1, (6 dc, 1 dec) x 4 times = 28. **Rounds 18 and 19**: Ch 1, 1 dc in each st = 28. Round 20: Ch 1, (5 dc, 1 dec) x 4 times = 24. Rounds 21 and 22: Ch 1, 1 dc in each st = 24. Round 23: Ch 1, (4 dc, 1 dec) x 4 times = 20. Rounds 24 and 25: 1 dc in each st = 20. Round 26: Ch 1, (8 dc, 1 dec) x 2 times = 18. **Round 27**: Ch 1,1 dc in each st = 18.

Round 28: Ch 1, (4 dc, 1 dec) x 3 times = 15. Round 29: Ch 1,1 dc in each st = 15. Round 30: Ch 1, (3 dc, 1 dec) x 3 times = 12. Round 31: Ch 1,1 dc in each st = 12. Round 32: Ch 1, (2 dc, 1 dec) x 3 times = 9. Continue decreasing until the end. Cut the yarn and weave the ends.

HAT DECORATION

Go back to the beginning of hat. Use Anchor Creativa Fino white yarn 01331. In the remaining loop of the chain at base make: **Round 1**: Ch 1 (does not count as st), 20 dc, 1 dec, 21 dc, 1 dec = 43. **Round 2 and 3**: 1 dc in each st = 43. Cut the yarn and weave. Turn up the stripe and using Anchor Stranded Cotton white 0002 embroider the star in straight stitch to decorate (see chart).

HAIR

Cut 50 cm pieces of Anchor Creativa Fino 00426 yarn (as many as you want) to make braids and fringe.

Attach to head: fold each piece of yarn half and with a 2.5 mm crochet hook introduce in each stitch of head around the face. You have to try it first and define the face area.

Make this for three or for rows as you wish. Make braids and position fringe, tie braids with Anchor Metallic red yarn 00318, Trim.

As the doll is having a hat, do not cover all of the head with hair, only around face where it's necessary.

Once hair is done, put the hat in place and secure it to the head and hair with some stitches (use white yarn).

ASSEMBLY DOLL

Position arms, secure with pins and sew to the body. Sew legs in the bottom gap of body/dress. The legs should remain soft. **Do not** stiffen.

SCARF

Use 3 mm crochet hook and Anchor Creativa Fino white yarn 01331 make ch 9.


Row 1: 1 htr in the 3rd chain from hook, 6 htr, ch 2, turn.

Row 2: BLO 7 htr, ch 2 turn.

Repeat row 2 working **BLO** htr (the entire scarf) make as many rows as you want to complete the scarf.

Wrap around the doll's neck.

Glamorous Pinecones

Made with Anchor Metallic (small pinecones only) and 2,5 mm hook TENSION 25 sts and 28 round = 10 x 10 cm in double crochet

Made with Anchor Metallic (big pinecones only) and 2,75 mm hook TENSION 24 sts and 28 round = 10 x 10 cm in double crochet

ABBREVIATIONS

Ch Chain Dc Double Crochet St Stitch Slip stitch SI St Treble Crochet Tr Inc Increase Dec Decrease Yarn over Yo

BASIC PATTERN Chain. Slip Stitch. Double Crochet. Treble Crochet.

SPIRAL ROUNDS: to identify the beginning round, place a stitch marker. Do not closed with 1 sl st. Start the round with 1 dc in the first dc of the previous round.

INCREASE: make 2 stitch in same stitch.

STITCHES CLOSED TOGETHER: do not fasten off the last loop of every st, then yo and fasten off all loops on hook.

DECREASE: work 2 dc together.

PINECONES BIG PINECONES

Cone Round 1: Make a Magic Ring with 6 dc = 6. Continue by working in spiral rounds and in back loop only. Round 2: 1 inc in each st = 12 Round 3: (2 dc, 1 inc) x 4 times = 16 Round 4: (2 dc, 1 inc) x 5 times, 1 dc = 21 Round 5: 1 dc in each st = 21 Round 6: (2 dc, 1 dec) x 5 times, 1 dc = 16 Round 7 and 8: 1 dc in each st = 16
Round 9: (2 dc, 1 dec) x 4 times = 12 fill with stuffing
Round 10: 1 dec x 6 times = 6
Continue decreasing till closing. Put some more stuffing if needed.
Do not cut the yarn, turn and continue crocheting the petals.

Pine Petals

In the same stitch you close (and using the front loops of the stitches), ch 3, in the next st 2 tr closed together, ch 3 and sl st in the next st, and repeat till you have 6 petals. (The first 6 petals have 2 tr closed together). From the next row on, try to alternate the place of the petals. Ch 3, in the next st 3 tr closed together, ch 3 and sl st in the next 2 sts. Continue making petals till you reach the top of the cone. Finish the pinecone. In the centre of the magic ring, ch 6, in the 2 nd ch from hook, make 5 dc. Cut the yarn and weave the ends.

SMALL PINECONES

Cone

Round 1: Make a Magic Ring with 6 dc = 6. Continue by working in spiral rounds and in back loop only. **Round 2:** 1 inc in each st = 12 **Round 3:** (2 dc, 1 inc) x 4 times = 16 **Round 4 and 5:** 1 dc in each st = 16 **Round 6:** (2 dc, 1 dec) x 4 times = 12 **Round 7 and 8:** 1 dc in each st = 12 fill with stuffing **Round 9:** 1 dec x 6 times = 6 Continue decreasing till closing. Put some more stuffing if needed. Do not cut the yarn, turn and continue crocheting the petals.

Small Pine Petals

In the same stitch you close (and using the front loops of the stitches), ch 3, in the next st 2 tr closed together, ch 3 and sl st in the next st, and repeat till you have 6 petals. (Small pine petals have 2 tr closed together). From the next row on, try to alternate the place of the petals. Continue making petals till you reach the top of the cone. Finish the pinecone. In the centre of the magic ring, ch 6, in the 2 nd ch from hook, make 5 dc. Cut the yarn and weave the ends.

Make as many pinecones as you like to decorate your wreath.

SPIRAL ROUNDS: to identify the beginning round, place a st marker. Do not closed with 1 sl st. Start the round with 1 dc in the first dc of the previous round.

INCREASE: make 2 st in same st.

DECREASE: (INVISIBLE DECREASE FOR AMIGURUMI)

Work 2 dc together as follows: Insert needle in FL (front loop) of first st, hold, then insert needle in the FL of second st, yo and fasten off all loops on hook.

BIG MUSHROOM

Bottom

Use Anchor Creativa Fino white yarn and crochet hook 2,75 mm. Round 1: Make a Magic Ring with 6 dc = 6. Continue by working in spiral rounds. Round 2: 1 inc in each st = 12. Round 3: (BLO) 1 dc in each st = 12. Pound 4 and 5: 1 do in each st = 12.

Round 4 and 5: 1 dc in each st = 12. Round 6: (1 dec, 4 dc) x 2 times = 10. Round 7 and 8: 1 dc in each st = 10 Stuff with fiber fill stuffing. Round 9: (1 dec, 3 dc) x 2 times = 8. Round 10: 1 dc in each st = 8. Round 11: 1 dec, 6 dc = 7. Round 12: 1 inc x 7 times = 14. Round 13: BLO (1 dc, 1 inc) x 7 times = 21. Round 14: BLO (2 dc, 1 inc) x 7 times = 28. Round 15: BLO (13 dc, 1 inc) x 2 times = 30. Stuff again and cut the yarn leaving a small tail.

Use **Anchor Creativa Fino** red yarn and crochet hook 2,75 mm. **Round 1:** Make a Magic Ring with 6 dc = 6. Continue by working in spiral rounds. **Round 2:** 1 inc in each st = 12.

Round 3: (1 dc, 1 inc) x 6 times = 18. **Round 4:** (2 dc, 1 inc) x 6 times = 24. **Round 5:** 1 dc in each st = 24.

Round 6: (3 dc, 1 inc.) x 6 times = 30

Round 7: 1 dc in each st = 30. Cut the yarn and leave a tail to assemble the cap to the bottom.

Assembly:

With the **Anchor Creativa Fino** white yarn and the tapestry needle make some French knots on the top of the mushroom's cap; wrap the yarn it around the needle 2 times. Put the cap on the bottom of the mushroom and sew carefully. Weave all the yarn ends. Your mushroom is ready.

SMALL MUSHROOM

This pattern is the same for both yarns **Anchor Metallic** and **Anchor Creativa Fino**, the differences are as follows:

Anchor Metallic yarn and 2,5 mm hook

Tension:

25 sts and 28 rows = 10×10 cm in double crochet

Anchor Creativa Fino yarn and 2,5 mm hook

Tension: 24 sts and 26 rows = 10×10 cm in double crochet

Bottom

Use white yarn **Round 1:** Make a Magic Ring with 8 dc = 8. Continue by working in spiral rounds. **Round 2:** (1 inc, 3 dc) x 2 times = 10. **Round 3:** 1 dc in each st = 10. **Round 4:** (1 dec, 3 dc) x 2 times = 8. **Round 5 and 6:** 1 dc in each st = 8. **Round 7:** 1 inc x 8 times = 16 Stuff slightly. **Round 8: BLO** (1 inc, 3 dc) x 4 times = 20. Cut the yarn, leaving a small tail. Put some more stuffing if needed.

Cap Use red yarn

Round 1: Make a Magic Ring with 8 dc = 8. Continue by working in spiral rounds.
Round 2: 1 inc in each st = 16.
Round 3: (1 inc, 3 dc) x 4 times = 20.
Round 4: 1 dc in each st = 20.
Cut the yarn and leave a tail to assemble the cap to the bottom.

Assembly:

With the white yarn and the tapestry needle make some French knots on the top of the mushroom's cap; wrap the yarn it around the needle 2 times. Put the cap on the bottom of the mushroom and sew carefully. Weave all the yarn ends.

Your mushroom is ready.

Make as many mushrooms as you like to decorate your wreath.

SPIRAL ROUNDS: to identify the beginning round, place a stitch marker. Do not closed with 1 sl st. Start the round with 1 dc in the first dc of the previous round.

INCREASE: make 2 stitch in same stitch.

DECREASE: work 2 dc together.

PICOT STITCH = in same st (1 dc, ch 2, sl st in the first chain, 1 dc).

HOLLY SETS

Big holly leaves (9 Picots) Chain 15

Round 1: 1 dc in the 2nd ch from hook, 2 htr, 2 tr, 3 dtr, 2 tr, 2 htr, 2 dc = 14. Turn to work on the other side of the foundation chain, 1 dc in the previous stitch, 1 dc in the next stitch, 2 htr, 2 tr, 3 dtr, 2 tr, 2 htr, 1 dc = 14. **Round 2:** Ch 1, sl st, in the next 2 stitches. *In the next stitch make a Picot stitch,1 sl st in the next 2 stitches*. Repeat from * to* three more times. You have to have 4 Picot stitches on this side of the Holly. Make one more Picot stitch at the tip of the leaf.

Turn the work and continue the same way in the other side. When reach the end of the leaf, 1 sl st in the ch and make a little stem. Ch 5 and from the second ch make 4 sl st in that chain, continue to sl st to form the centre of the leaf.

Cut the yarn and weave all the ends. (See chart A).

Small holly leaves (7 Picots)

Chain 12

Round 1: 1 dc in the 2nd ch from hook, 2 htr, 2 tr, 1 dtr, 2 tr, 1 htr, 2 dc = 11. Turn to work on the other side of the foundation chain, 1 dc in the previous stitch, 1 dc in the next stitch, 1 htr, 2 tr, 1 dtr, 2 tr, 2 htr, 1 dc = 11.

Round 2: Ch 1, sl st, in the next 2 stitches. *In the next stitch make a Picot stitch,1 sl st in the next 2 stitches*. Repeat from * to* two more times.

You have to have 3 Picot stitches on this side of the Holly. Make one more Picot stitch at the tip of the leaf.

Turn the work and continue the same way in the other side. When reach the end of the leaf, 1 sl st in the ch and make a little stem. Ch 5 and from the second ch make 4 sl st in that chain, continue to sl st to form the centre of the leaf.

Cut the yarn and weave all the ends. (See chart B).

Holly berries

Round 1: Make a Magic Ring with 6 dc = 6 Round 2: 1 inc in each stitch = 12 Round 3: 1 dc in each stitch = 12 Round 4: 1 dec x 6 times = 6 (See chart C).

Stuff slightly.

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail to close the remaining stitches.


Using the tapestry needle and only in the front loops of the stitches, carefully close them, giving the berry a ball shape.

Crochet as many Holly leaves and berries you want. You can make sets of 2 or 3 leaves with 2 or 3 berries.

Make as many holly sets as you like to decorate your wreath.

Little Star Pattern

TENSION

25 sts and 28 rows = 10×10 cm in double crochet

ABBREVIATIONS

ch(s)	chain(s)
dc	double crochet
htr	half treble crochet
sl st	slip stitch

Row 1: Make a Magic Ring with 10 dc = 10

Row 2: Chain 4. Dc in the second chain from hook, htr in the next 2 chs. Sl st in the second stitch of the magic ring. This is one point of the little star. Repeat to make the five points. Cut the yarn and weave the ends.

Crochet as many little stars as you want.

WASHING ADVICE

• Always wash in as warm a water temperature as possible - up to the temperature recommended, with a short spin. Use a lot of water if hand washing. For darker colours we recommend the use of discolouration sheets.

- Do not bleach.
- Do not tumble dry. Drip-dry on a horizontal surface.
- Iron at a low temperature using a damp cloth.
- Professional dry cleaning in tetrachloroethylene.

• Do not use optical brighteners (or any detergent containing optical brighteners).
