# Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

## Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice® Red Hook Cheeseburger Dog Toy

Pattern Number: L50177

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy (Level 2)

**SIZE:** One Size

About 5 in. (13 cm) tall.

### MATERIALS

- 860-123 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Beige  
1 Ball (A)
- 860-126 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Chocolate  
1 Ball (B)
- 860-174 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Olive  
1 Ball (C)
- 860-158 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Mustard  
1 Ball (D)
- 860-180 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Cranberry  
1 Ball (E)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size G-6 (4 mm)
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials  
Small amount of fiberfill stuffing

*\*Vanna's Choice® (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic*

***400, 401, 403:** 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon  
**402:** 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m)*

***Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers:** 3 ozs (85 g) , 145 yards (133 meters)*

***Twists:** 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111 meters)*



### MATERIALS NOTE

Materials are sufficient to make multiple Toys.

### GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**sc2tog (sc 2 sts together)** (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

## NOTES:

1. Buns, Hamburger and garnishes are worked separately, then sewn together.
2. All pieces are worked in continuous rnds; do not join or turn unless otherwise instructed.
3. We used a smaller hook than usual for this yarn to create a dense fabric for this toy.

## TOP BUN

With A, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in first ch; place marker to indicate beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnd 2:** Work 2 sc in each st around – you will have 12 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 3:** Work \*2 sc in next st, sc in next st; rep from \* around – 18 sc.

**Rnd 4:** Work \*2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from \* around – 24 sc.

**Rnd 5:** Work \*2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; rep from \* around – 30 sc.

**Rnd 6:** Work \*2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts; rep from \* around – 36 sc.

**Rnd 7:** Work \*2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts; rep from \* around – 42 sc.

**Rnd 8:** Work \*2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts; rep from \* around – 48 sc.

**Rnds 9-13:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 14:** Working through back loops only, \*sc2tog, sc in each of next 6 sts; rep from \* around – 42 sc.

**Rnd 15:** \*Sc2tog, sc in next 5 sts; rep from \* around – 36 sc.

**Rnd 16:** \*Sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts; rep from \* around – 30 sc.

**Rnd 17:** \*Sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts; rep from \* around – 24 sc.

Begin stuffing piece firmly.

**Rnd 18:** \*Sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts; rep from \* around – 18 sc.

**Rnd 19:** \*Sc2tog, sc in next st; rep from \* around – 12 sc.

Finish stuffing piece.

**Rnd 20:** Sc2tog around – 6 sc.

Fasten off and cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail into blunt needle and weave through last rnd. Pull gently to draw sts together and knot.

## BOTTOM BUN

With A, ch 2.

**Rnds 1-8:** Rep Rnds 1-8 of Top Bun – 48 sc.

**Rnds 9-11:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 12:** \*Sc2tog, sc in next 6 sts; rep from \* around – 42 sc.

**Rnd 13:** \*Sc2tog, sc in next 5 sts; rep from \* around – 36 sc.

**Rnd 14:** \*Sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts; rep from \* around – 30 sc.

**Rnd 15:** \*Sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts; rep from \* around – 24 sc.

Begin stuffing piece firmly.

**Rnd 16:** \*Sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts; rep from \* around – 18 sc.

**Rnd 17:** \*Sc2tog, sc in next st; rep from \* around – 12 sc.

Finish stuffing piece.

**Rnd 18:** Sc2tog around – 6 sc.

Fasten off and cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail into blunt needle and weave through last rnd. Pull gently to draw sts together and knot.

## HAMBURGER

With B, ch 2.

**Rnds 1-18:** Rep Rnds 1-18 of Bottom Bun.

Fasten off and cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail into blunt needle and weave through last

rnd. Pull gently to draw sts together and knot.

### LETTUCE

With C, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in first ch; place marker to indicate beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnd 2:** Work 2 sc in each st around – 12 sc.

**Rnd 3:** Work \*2 sc in next st, sc in next st; rep from \* around – 18 sc.

**Rnd 4:** Work \*2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from \* around – 24 sc.

**Rnd 5:** Work \*2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; rep from \* around – 30 sc.

**Rnd 6:** Work \*2 sc in next st, sc in next st; rep from \* around – 45 sc.

**Rnd 7:** Work \*2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from \* around – 60 sc.

**Rnd 8:** Work \*2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; rep from \* around – 75 sc.

**Rnd 9:** Work \*2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts; rep from \* around – 90 sc.

Fasten off.

### TOMATOES (make 2)

With E, ch 2.

**Rnds 1-5:** Rep Rnds 1-5 of Top Bun.

Fasten off.

### CHEESE

With D, ch 17.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 16 sc.

**Rows 2-17:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Sew Hamburger onto Bottom Bun. Sew Lettuce and Tomatoes onto Hamburger then sew on Top Bun.
